Re: Approval of Renewal Cardroom Business License with Condition(s) (GEGE-001295)

Dear Kenneth Bacon:

On April 18, 2024, the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) approved your application for renewal Cardroom Business License valid through April 30, 2026, with the following condition(s).

- 1. Sacramento Casino Royale, LLC and William Blanas must abide by all terms and conditions set forth in the Stipulated Settlement.*
- 2. The Cardroom Business Licenses of Sacramento Casino Royale, LLC and William Blanas will remain suspended until the sale of assets to and licensure of new ownership is complete; or until the expiration of without renewal this Cardroom Business License, whichever is earlier.*

That decision was stayed for 30-days to provide you the opportunity to request an evidentiary hearing.

On April 19, 2024, the Commission received your assent to the conditions placed on your License; therefore, the Commission's decision to approve the License with the above condition(s) is now final. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 19870, subd. (c).)

License Certificate

Upon notification that Casino Royale has reopened for business, A Cardroom Business License certificate and endorsement will be issued.
