Re: Interim Renewal Cardroom Business License –
Tres Lounge and Casino (GEGE-001330)

Dear Mr. Kirkland:

On July 20, 2023, the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) approved the issuance of an additional Interim Renewal License to GLCR, Inc. dba Tres Lounge and Casino, valid through **July 31, 2025**, continuing with the following condition:

Tres Lounge and Casino must submit a copy of their business license with the City of Watsonville within 90 days of approval to both the Bureau of Gambling Control and the Commission.

That decision was stayed for 30-days to provide you the opportunity to request an evidentiary hearing.

On July 20, 2023, the Commission received your assent to the condition(s) placed on your license; therefore, the Commission’s decision to approve the issuance of an addition Interim Renewal License with the above condition(s) is now final (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 19870(c)).

Upon notification from the Bureau of Gambling Control that Tres Lounge and Casino has an approved location and will be reopening the Gambling Establishment, the Commission will issue Tres Lounge and Casino the certificate and endorsement valid through July 31, 2025 reflecting the new address.

Condition Compliance

The discussion regarding the placement of the condition can be found in the meeting minutes and audio recording of the meeting on our website, www.cgcc.ca.gov, under the meetings tab and select your corresponding meeting date in the audio column.

As a reminder, it is ultimately the Owner-Licensee’s responsibility to remain in compliance with any conditions placed on the license. The Commission does **not** send reminder notices for compliance with the condition(s). **Failure to comply with Commission**

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conditions may result in consequences up to and including denial or revocation of licensure.



An application to renew the Cardroom Business license will be due to the Bureau 120-days prior to the license expiration date. The Bureau will send a courtesy notification letter approximately 150-days prior to the license expiration. However, it is ultimately your responsibility to ensure the renewal applications are submitted timely.
