23	PURPOSE OF THIS STIPULATED SETTLEMENT		
24	This Stipulated Settlement seeks to resolve the allegations in the Second Amended		
25	Accusation and Statement of Issues (Second Amended Accusation) in this matter and the issue of		
26	Michael A. Whiteley, Jr.'s (Respondent) continued suitability to hold a state gambling license.		
27	The Second Amended Accusation that was filed with the Californian Gambling Control		
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		Whiteley, Jr.; Mike's Card Casino)	

1	Commission (Commission) and served on the Respondent by the California Department of	
2	Justice, Bureau of Gambling Control (Bureau) sets forth the violations of, and lack of suitability	
3	for continued licensure under, the Gambling Control Act (Act) (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 19800 et	
4	seq.) and the regulations promulgated thereunder.	
5	PARTIES AND JURISDICTION	
6	1. Wayne J. Quint, Jr. (former complainant) brought the Accusation solely in his official	
7	capacity as the then Chief of the Bureau. Nathan DaValle (Complainant) is now the Acting	
8	Director of the Bureau and is acting herein solely in his official capacity.	
9	2. Respondent is the sole proprietor of Mike's Card Casino, a licensed gambling	
10	establishment, located at 824 North Yosemite Avenue in Oakdale, California. Respondent's	
11	Owner's Gambling License number is GEOW-002034. Mike's Card Casino's License number is	
12	GEGE-000811. Respondent's license expired on July 31, 2016. However, at its July 7, 2016,	
13	meeting, the Commission issued Respondent an interim renewal license, which is valid through	
14	July 31, 2018, or the final conclusion of the proceedings in this matter.	
15	3. On May 24, 2016, Respondent was served with the original Accusation, a Statement	
16	to Respondent, a Request for Discovery, copies of Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6	
17	and 11507.7, and two copies of the Notice of Defense form. On or about July 19, 2016,	
18	Respondent was served with the First Amended Accusation and Statement of Issues. On or about	
19	May 16, 2017, Respondent was served with the Second Amended Accusation. Copies of all these	
20	documents were also filed with the Commission at or about the time they were served on	
21	Respondent.	
22	4. Respondent submitted a Notice of Defense dated June 16, 2016. <sup>1</sup>	
23	ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS	
24	5. Respondent has carefully reviewed, and has discussed with counsel, the legal and	
25	factual allegations in the Second Amended Accusation. Respondent has also carefully reviewed,

and has discussed with counsel, this Stipulated Settlement. Respondent fully understands the
 terms and conditions contained within this Stipulated Settlement and the effects thereof.

3 6. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a 4 hearing before the Commission on his suitability for licensure and all the allegations in the 5 Second Amended Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel of his choice at his own 6 expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to present 7 evidence and testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the 8 attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to apply for reconsideration 9 and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights afforded by the Act, the regulations 10 promulgated thereunder, and all other applicable laws.

7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and
every right set forth in paragraph 6 above, withdraws his Notice of Defense, and agrees to be
bound by this Stipulated Settlement.

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## **STIPULATED AGREEMENT OF SETTLEMENT**

8. For the purposes of resolving the allegations in the Second Amended Accusation,
the issue of his continued suitability for licensure, and for any other matters now and in the future
involving the Commission or the Bureau, Respondent knowingly and voluntarily admits that all
the factual and legal allegations in the Second Amended Accusation are true, accurate, and
complete, and that such allegations provide a sufficient legal and factual basis to revoke his
license and deny his license renewal.

9. Respondent understands and agrees that the admissions made in paragraph 8 above
 may be entered into evidence in any legal proceeding brought or prosecuted by the Commission
 or the Bureau, as if those admissions were made under oath and penalty of perjury.

- 10. Upon the effective date of the Decision and Order issued by the Commission
- 25 adopting this Stipulated Settlement, Respondent's state gambling license, number GEOW-
- 26 002034, shall be renewed and immediately thereafter revoked.<sup>2</sup> The revocation, however, shall

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1 be stayed as provided in paragraphs 11 and 12 of this Stipulated Settlement. Respondent 2 acknowledges, understands, and agrees that the stay of the revocation of his state gambling 3 license is intended solely to preserve the existence of the Mike's Card Casino license, number 4 GEGE-000811, for purposes of Business and Professions Code sections 19962 and 19963, and to 5 allow for a possible sale of 100 percent of that gambling establishment's assets. Respondent 6 acknowledges, understands, and agrees that the Commission, exercising its authority under the 7 Act, must approve the sale of the gambling establishment's assets, and the licensure of any person 8 who wishes to purchase those assets and carry on a gambling operation at the gambling 9 establishment currently know as Mike's Card Casino.

10 The revocation of Respondent's state gambling license shall be stayed for no longer 11. 11 than 12 months from the effective date of the Decision and Order issued by the Commission 12 adopting this Stipulated Settlement (Stay Period). Under no circumstances shall the Stay Period 13 be lengthened or extended. However, the Stay Period shall be shortened and the stay lifted upon 14 the earlier of (i) the closing of the sale of Mike's Card Casino's assets within the Stay Period, 15 which includes obtaining both the Commission's approval of the sale of those assets and the 16 licensure of the person(s) who wishes to purchase them; or (ii) a determination by the Bureau, in 17 its discretion, that Respondent has violated any provision of the Act or the regulations 18 promulgated thereunder. 12. Upon the earlier of the expiration or shortening of the Stay Period, as provided for in

19 20 paragraph 11, the stay of the revocation of Respondent's state gambling license shall be 21 automatically and immediately lifted and Respondent's state gambling license revoked, without 22 hearing or any right to appeal. Respondent knowingly, voluntarily and expressly waives any right 23 to a hearing on such a revocation, and any right to appeal, or to contest in any manner, such a

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- (...continued) 25 previously determined that it could not stay a denial of the renewal of a state gambling license when an interim renewal license has been issued. To comply with the Commission's prior 26 directions in such cases and to effectuate the ultimate goal of this Stipulated Settlement, Respondent's state gambling license must be renewed and then immediately revoked. There is no 27 prohibition on staying a revocation in the Act.

2 Respondent also agrees to pay to the Bureau \$65,000 for the costs it incurred in 13. 3 investigating and prosecuting this case, as well as a \$60,000 penalty for his violations of the Act, 4 as provided for in paragraphs 14 thru 16. The cost recovery shall be paid, and will be deposited, 5 in accordance with Business and Professions Code sections 19930, subdivision (f), and 19950, 6 subdivision (b). The penalty shall be paid, and will be deposited, in accordance with Business 7 and Professions Code section 19950, subdivision (a)

8 Should Respondent close the sale of Mike's Card Casino's assets within the Stay 14. 9 Period for a gross sales price of \$350,000 or less, then the Bureau agrees to waive collection of 10 the \$125,000 (\$65,000 for costs and \$60,000 penalty) provided for in paragraph 13. Should 11 Respondent close the sale of the gambling establishment's assets within the Stay Period for a 12 gross sales price in excess of \$350,000 (\$350,000.01 or greater), then Respondent shall pay to the 13 Bureau the \$125,000 provided for in paragraph 13.

14 15. As part of any approved sale of Mike's Card Casino's assets for a gross sales prices 15 in excess of \$350,000, Respondent shall instruct both the purchaser and the escrow holder to pay 16 the \$125,000, provided for in paragraph 13, at the closing directly to the Bureau, which shall have 17 a lien on the proceeds of the sale for the gambling establishment.

18 16. If Respondent defaults in any way in payment of the \$125,000 provided for in 19 paragraph 13, then he expressly agrees that the Commission's Decision and Order adopting this 20 Stipulated Settlement may be presented to the Sacramento County Superior Court and, after 21 notice to Respondent and an opportunity to be heard, judgment entered thereon. Respondent 22 further agrees that the judgment shall include interest, calculated at the maximum rate allowed by 23 law to accrue from the effective date of the Commission's Decision and Order. Respondent also 24 agrees that the judgment shall include the Bureau's costs of obtaining, enforcing, and collecting 25 the judgment. Costs shall include reasonable attorney fees calculated at then-prevailing hourly 26 rates for services provided in the private sector for attorneys of comparable experience.

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Respondent further expressly acknowledges, understands, and agrees that he shall 17. 28 forever be deemed disqualified, unqualified and unsuitable for licensure, registration or

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permitting in any capacity by the Commission, or any successor agency, commencing on the day
 the stay is lifted and his state gambling license is revoked.

3 18. The parties agree that this Stipulated Settlement fully resolves their dispute
4 concerning the Second Amended Accusation and Respondent's suitability for licensure.

5 19. This Stipulated Settlement shall be subject to adoption by the Commission.
6 Respondent understands and specifically agrees that counsel for the Complainant, and the
7 Bureau's staff, may communicate directly with the Commission regarding this Stipulated
8 Settlement, without notice to, or participation by, Respondent or his counsel, and that no such
9 communication shall be deemed a prohibited ex parte communication. Respondent specifically
10 acknowledges and agrees that such communications are permissible pursuant to Government
11 Code section 11430.30, subdivision (b).

12 20. By signing this Stipulated Settlement, Respondent understands and agrees that he 13 may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the Stipulated Settlement prior to the time the 14 Commission considers and acts upon it. If the Commission fails to adopt this Stipulated 15 Settlement as its Decision and Order, this Stipulated Settlement shall be of no force or effect, and, 16 except for actions taken pursuant to this paragraph and paragraph 19 above, it shall be 17 inadmissible in any legal action between the parties. The Commission's consideration of this 18 Stipulated Settlement shall not disgualify it from any further action regarding Respondent's 19 licensure, including, but not limited to, disposition of the Second Amended Accusation by a 20 decision and order following a hearing on the merits.

21 21. The parties agree that a photocopy, facsimile or electronic copy of this Stipulated
22 Settlement, including copies with signatures thereon, shall have the same force and effect as an
23 original.

24 22. In consideration of the above admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the
25 Commission may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the Decision and
26 Order adopting this Stipulated Settlement.

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## ACCEPTANCE

Respondent has carefully read and considered the above Stipulated Settlement. Respondent has discussed the above Stipulated Settlement's terms and effects with legal counsel. Respondent understands the Stipulated Settlement and the effects it will have on his state gambling license. Respondent also understands that in addition to his state gambling license being revoked and the possible payment of \$65,000 in cost recovery and a \$60,000 penalty, he will forever be deemed disqualified, unqualified and unsuitable for licensure, registration or permitting in any capacity by the Commission commencing on the day the stay is lifted and his state gambling license is revoked. Respondent enters into this Stipulated Settlement voluntarily, knowingly and intelligently, and agrees to be bound by its terms.
