The Commission may adopt the proposed regulations as modified July 23, 2014; adopt the proposed regulations with additional modifications, subject to a 15-day written comment period pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(c); or direct that modification to the proposed regulations be prepared and noticed for a 15-day written comment period before taking any further action.

The Commission affords an opportunity to members of the public to address the Commission on items of interest that are within the Commission's jurisdiction. The Commission is not permitted to take action on items that are not identified on the agenda. The Commission "reserves the right to limit speakers if necessary to provide an adequate opportunity for all to be heard."
