NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and the California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 44, the California Gambling Control Commission (“Commission”) is providing notice of changes made to the proposed regulations concerning Disciplinary Regulations (Chapter 10. Discipline, Hearings, and Decisions).

A formal 45-day public notice and comment period was held from March 3, 2006, through April 20, 2006, and a public hearing was held on April 20, 2006. Based on comments received by the Commission, changes were made to these regulations, resulting in a 15-day public notice and comment period, held from May 23, 2006 through June 7, 2006.

Based on comments received by the Commission, further changes are being made to these regulations.

If you have any comments regarding the proposed changes, please submit them in writing between November 6, 2006 and November 21, 2006. All comments must be submitted to the Commission no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, November 21, 2006.
