

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF MODIFIED TEXT

Second 15-Day Change

(Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(c), and California Code of Regulations, Title 1, Section 44)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Gambling Control Commission has proposed modifications to the rulemaking package entitled: *Minimum Internal Control Standards (MICS) for Gambling Establishments; Checks, Credit, ATMs and Unclaimed Property*, CGCC-GCA-2007-R-6. A formal 45-day public notice and comment period was held from January 25 through March 12, 2008, and a noticed public hearing was held April 10, 2008. A first 15-day change notice was published and a public comment period was held from September 22 through October 8, 2008. Based on comments received by the Commission during the first 15-day change comment period, changes are again being made to these proposed regulations.

Modifications are proposed to the text of new sections 12388 and 12410 in Title 4 of the California Code of Regulations. A copy of the modified text is enclosed. The text of the originally proposed changes and the modified text is also available on the Commission's Web site, at www.cgcc.ca.gov, under "Laws and Regulations; Gambling Control Act Regulations; 2008 Proposed Gambling Control Act Regulations / Documents."
