12	§ 12004. Notification of Contact Information Change of Address.
13	A registrant or licensee shall report to the Commission any change of address-contact
14	information, whether residence address, address of record or mailing address, phone number or
15	any other contact information, within ten days of such that change on a form entitled "Notice of
16	Address Contact Information Change," CGCC-032 (New 06-05 Rev. 06/12), which is attached in
17	Appendix A to this Chapter. This section does not apply to the physical relocation of a gambling
18	establishment.

22	CHAPTER 7. CONDITIONS OF OPERATION FOR GAMBLING ESTABLISHMENTS.
23	ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS
24	§ 12364. Relocation of Gambling Establishment.
25	(a) For purposes of this section, "relocation" means the physical relocation of a gambling
26	establishment from one location to another location for which a different parcel number has been
27	assigned by a county assessor.
28	(b) An owner-licensee shall notify the Bureau of a planned relocation of a gambling
29	establishment at least 90 days in advance of the intended commencement of gambling operations
30	at the new location on the form entitled "Notice of Relocation," CGCC-050 (New 06/12), which
31	is attached in Appendix A to this Chapter.
32	(1) If the new location is more than 1,000 feet from any boundary line of its governing local

- 1 jurisdiction, the owner-licensee shall, except as otherwise provided, submit to the Bureau all of
- 2 the following prior to the commencement of gambling operations:
- 3 (A) A copy of the licensee's fully executed rental or lease agreement for, or evidence of the
- 4 licensee's ownership of, the proposed new location.
- 5 (B) A copy of the licensee's fire safety and evacuation plan for the proposed new location,
- 6 prepared in compliance with Section 12370.
- 7 (C) A copy of the licensee's security and surveillance plan for the proposed new location,
- 8 prepared in compliance with Section 12372.
- 9 (D) Documentary evidence of the issuance to the licensee of all required approvals, licenses
- and permits by any applicable local jurisdictional entity concerning the new location; e.g.,
- business licenses, occupancy permits, conditional use permits, zoning variances, local gaming
- 12 licenses, etc.
- (E) Documentary evidence of the issuance to the licensee of all required approvals, licenses
- and permits by any applicable state or federal agency concerning the new location; e.g., liquor
- licenses, check cashing permits, etc. These documents are not required to be submitted prior to
- the commencement of gambling operations, but must be received by the Bureau prior to the
- commencement of the associated activity.
- 18 (2) If the new location is 1,000 feet or less from any boundary line of its governing local
- 19 jurisdiction, the owner-licensee shall, in addition to the documentation required by paragraph (1),
- and prior to the commencement of gambling operations, submit signed documentation from the
- appropriate agency or department in the neighboring jurisdiction confirming that the agency or
- department has no objections to the planned location of the gambling establishment. Any
- objections to the proposed location must be based upon evidence of probable negative effects
- resulting from the gambling establishment's relocation or proof that the legitimate interests of
- residents in the neighboring jurisdiction are threatened. For purposes of this section,
- 26 "neighboring jurisdiction" means any other adjoining jurisdiction whose common boundary line
- with the governing local jurisdiction is 1,000 feet or less from the proposed new location of the
- 28 gambling establishment.
- (c) If an owner-licensee cannot obtain the signed documentation required by paragraph (2) of
- subsection (b), the gambling establishment shall not be relocated without Commission review.
- To request Commission review, the owner-licensee shall submit the Notice of Relocation form to

- the Bureau and so indicate. A document describing all efforts made to obtain the confirmation
- 2 specified in paragraph (2) of subsection (b) shall be included with the request. The relocation
- 3 review request shall be forwarded to the Commission within 10 days of its receipt by the Bureau
- 4 for placement on a Commission agenda for consideration. The Commission shall notify the
- 5 neighboring jurisdiction of the time and place of the Commission hearing in order for
- 6 representatives of that jurisdiction to have the opportunity to attend and be heard.

- 9 (d)(1) The Bureau shall schedule and conduct a site visit prior to the commencement of
- gambling operations at the new location or within 30 days after the commencement of gambling
- operations. A written report of the findings of the site visit shall be provided to the Commission,
- as well as any follow-up reports.
- (2) If the Bureau notes any deficiency, it shall issue a notice to correct the deficiency. The
- notice shall specify a reasonable time in which the deficiency is to be corrected. The
- commencement of gambling operations shall not be delayed nor the operation suspended unless
- the deficiency prevents substantial compliance with laws or regulations and materially threatens
- public safety or the integrity of the gambling operation, and the deficiency cannot be cured or
- 18 mitigated within a reasonable time. Failure to correct or otherwise mitigate the deficiency may
- be considered during the license renewal process and may result in disciplinary action under
- 20 Chapter 10 of this division.
- 21 (e) No gambling operations may be conducted at any new location until all the required
- approvals have been obtained and the provision of subsections (b) and, if applicable, (c) have
- been complied with.

- 27 gambling operations at the new location to ensure that the following internal controls meet the
- requirements of Article 3 of Chapter 7:
- (A) Drop and drop collection, pursuant to Section 12384;
- 30 (B) Count and count room functions, pursuant to Section 12385;
- 31 (C) Cage functions, pursuant to Section 12386;

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(D) Security, pursuant to Section 12395; and,

          (E) Surveillance, pursuant to Section 12396.

          (2) If the Bureau notes any deficiency in the internal controls listed in subparagraphs (A)
 3
      through (E), it shall issue a notice to the owner-licensee of the nature of the deficiency.

      Gambling operations may not begin until any deficiencies have been addressed.
 5
         (e) No gambling operations may be conducted at any new location until all the required
 6
      approvals have been obtained and the provisions of subsections (b), (c), if applicable, and (d)
 7

      have been complied with.

         (f) If any gambling operations are conducted in violation of subsection (e), the owner-licensee
10
      and each endorsed owner shall be subject to disciplinary action under Chapter 10 of this division.

      For the purposes of this subsection, each day or portion thereof, whether consecutive or not,
      during which any gambling operations are conducted in violation of subsection (e) shall
13
      constitute a separate violation.

         (g) Failure to timely notify the Bureau of any change pursuant to this section shall constitute a

      ground for disciplinary action under Chapter 10 of this division.
