

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF
MODIFIED TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS
15-Day Change**

(Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(c), and Title 1, California Code of Regulations, Section 44)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) has proposed modifications to the proposed regulatory action entitled: *Minimum Internal Control Standards (MICS) for Gambling Establishments Phase IV – Cage Operation and Functions; Security of Floor Banks, Gambling Equipment and Confidential Documents*; CGCC-GCA-2013-04-R. A formal 45-day written comment period was held from October 18, 2013 through December 2, 2013, pursuant to the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action duly published in the *California Regulatory Notice Register* on October 18, 2013 (Z-2013-1004-01, Register 2013, No. 42-Z, 10/18/2013). The proposed regulations were also considered by the Commission in a rulemaking hearing held on January 29, 2014.

Modifications to the originally proposed text of Sections 12386 and 12387 in Title 4 of the California Code of Regulations have been adopted by the Commission. A copy of the modified text is enclosed. The specific language of the originally proposed regulation and this modified text are also available on the Commission’s Web site, at www.cgcc.ca.gov, under “Regulations; Proposed Regulations.”
