

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF  
MODIFIED TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

(Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(c), and Title 1, California Code of Regulations, Section 44)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) has proposed modifications to the proposed regulatory action entitled: *Application Withdrawals and Abandonments, and Hearing Procedures*; CGCC-GCA-2014-02-R. A formal 45-day written comment period was held from February 21, 2014 through April 7, 2014, pursuant to the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action duly published in the *California Regulatory Notice Register* on February 21, 2014 (Z-2013-0211-05, Register 2014, No. 8-Z, 02/21/2014). The proposed regulations were also considered by the Commission in a rulemaking hearing held on June 18, 2014.

Modifications to the text of the proposed action, as noticed February 21, 2014, have been adopted by the Commission. A copy of the modified text is enclosed.
