

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF
MODIFIED TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS
15-DAY CHANGE**

(Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(c), and Title 1, California Code of Regulations, Section 44)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) has proposed modifications to the proposed regulatory action entitled: *Accounting and Financial Reporting for Gambling Enterprises, Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services, and Gambling Businesses*; CGCC-GCA-2014-04-R. A formal 45-day written comment period was held from May 2, 2014 through June 15, 2014, pursuant to the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action duly published in the *California Regulatory Notice Register* on May 2, 2014 (Z-2014-0421-02, Register 2014, No. 18-Z, 05/02/2014). The proposed regulations were also considered by the Commission in a rulemaking hearing held on July 23, 2014.

Modifications to the text of the proposed action, as noticed May 2, 2014, have been adopted by the Commission. A copy of the modified text is enclosed.
