

In this regulatory action, the Commission amends section 12505 of the California Code of Regulations to change authorization requirements for organizations conducting remote caller bingo games. With this regulation, organizations would only be required to obtain Commission authorizations for the initial application to conduct remote caller bingo games. Subsequent annual information updates would no longer require Commission approval.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 10/1/2014.

6 The California Gambling Control Commission hereby adopts the following changes in its
7 regulations contained in Division 18 of Title 4 of the California Code of Regulations:

9 CHAPTER 8. BINGO.

10 ARTICLE 3. REMOTE CALLER BINGO INTERIM LICENSES AND INTERIM WORK PERMITS.

11 **§ 12505. Authorization of Organizations Conducting Remote Caller Bingo Games.**

12 (a) No organization may conduct remote caller bingo games in this state unless it has been
13 authorized by the Commission pursuant to this article.

14 (b) Any organization requesting initial authorization by the Commission shall:

15 (1) Meet the requirements specified in section 326.3(b)(1-5) of the Penal Code.

16 (2) Submit to the Bureau a Statement of Eligibility to Conduct Remote Caller Bingo, BGC-
17 618 (Rev. 10/13), which is attached in Appendix C to this Chapter.

18 (3) Submit a non-refundable processing fee of \$50.00.

19 (c) ~~Any~~ organization authorized by the Commission shall annually submit the following to
20 the Bureau within 120 calendar days after the close of the organization's fiscal year:

21 (1) A Statement of Eligibility to Conduct Remote Caller Bingo, BGC-618, referred to in
22 paragraph (2) of subsection (b), specifying any changes in the information included in the
23 organization's last statement of eligibility filed with the Bureau.

24 (2) A non-refundable processing fee of \$25.00.

25 (d) Each statement received pursuant to ~~this section~~ subsection (b) shall be reviewed and, if
26 found to be complete and correct, shall be set for consideration at a noticed Commission
27 meeting. If the statement does not satisfy the requirements of this article, the applicant shall be
28 provided a written list of the deficiencies. The Commission reserves the right to refuse
29 authorization to any organization that does not meet the requirements specified in subsection (b).
