

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF  
MODIFIED TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS  
15-Day Change**

(Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(c), and Title 1, California Code of Regulations, Section 44)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) has proposed modifications to the proposed regulatory action entitled: *Program for Responsible Gambling*; CGCC-GCA-2015-01-R. A formal 45-day written comment period was held from March 6, 2015 through April 20, 2015, pursuant to the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action duly published in the *California Regulatory Notice Register* on March 5, 2015 (Z-2015-0224-09, Register 2015, No. 10-Z, 03/06/2015). The proposed regulations were also considered by the Commission in a rulemaking hearing held on July 29, 2015. An additional 15-day written comment period was held from August 14, 2015 through August 28, 2015.

Additional modifications to the text of the proposed action are being proposed; and a copy of the modified text is enclosed. The specific language of the originally proposed regulations, the previous modified text, and this modified text are available on the Commission's Web site, at [www.cgcc.ca.gov](http://www.cgcc.ca.gov), under "Regulations; Proposed Regulations."
