



## GAMING POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE



Do you have an interest in the California regulated gaming industry? Do you want to work collaboratively with other representatives of the California Cardroom industry, regulatory agencies and members with varied backgrounds and experiences on recommendations concerning existing controlled gaming policy? Then the Gaming Policy Advisory Committee (GPAC) is for you.

The California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) is currently accepting applications from individuals interested in serving as a member on the GPAC. The Commission currently has a vacancy within its Category G, member with an accounting background, seat. **Interested parties applying for consideration of appointment to this seat cannot be affiliated with any California gaming entity.**

### GPAC Mission Statement

To provide advisory recommendations to the California Gambling Control Commission concerning matters of controlled gaming regulatory policy and other relevant gambling related issues, with special attention to guaranteeing the integrity of gambling operations and to deal effectively with problem gambling.

### Business & Professions Code 19800 -- 19987

### Division 8, Chapter 5, Articles 1 - 17 (Gambling Control Act)

Section 19817: The commission shall establish and appoint a Gaming Policy Advisory Committee of 10 members. The committee shall be composed of representatives of controlled gambling licensees and members of the general public in equal numbers. The executive director shall, from time to time, convene the committee for the purpose of discussing matters of controlled gambling regulatory policy and any other relevant gambling-related issue. The recommendations concerning gambling policy made by the committee shall be presented to the commission, but shall be deemed advisory and not binding on the commission in the performance of its duties or functions. The committee may not advise the commission on Indian gaming.
