

CALIFORNIA GAMBLING CONTROL COMMISSION GAMING POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE NOTIFICATION OF TERM EXPIRATIONS

The California Gambling Control Commission's Gaming Policy Advisory Committee (GPAC) has five members whose term is set to expire on December 31, 2016. These five members currently occupy the following seats:

1. **Category A:** An employee from the Bureau of Gambling Control, Department of Justice
2. **Category B:** An agency or nonprofit concerned with problem gambling and/or gambling addiction
3. **Category D:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with 25 tables or more in operation
4. **Category E:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with less than 25 tables in operation
5. **Category F:** An applicant affiliated with local law enforcement from a local government where an approved ordinance allows legalized gaming

Per the current Selection Process, as approved and adopted by the Commissioners on August 25, 2016, the following process for Renewal of Terms shall be followed:

A notification of the expiring terms of GPAC Committee Members will be sent to the Commission's mailing list, and posted on the Commission's website, not less than 2 months prior to the expiration dates. Members of the Committee in good standing, who want to remain on the Committee for another term, meet the requirements of the category they were elected to and all other requirements of the GPAC, and who run unopposed in their category, may be recommended to the Commission with a consensus from the GPAC without a formal interview process.

Members of the Gaming Policy Advisory Committee may serve three (3) consecutive terms of up to two (2) years each. All current GPAC members are eligible to renew their term; however, **the Commission will accept applications for anyone who is eligible and wishes to be considered for appointment to any of the seats identified above until Monday, November 28, 2016.** Interviews will be scheduled in mid-December.
