

**CALIFORNIA GAMBLING CONTROL COMMISSION

NOTIFICATION OF 2018 TERM EXPIRATIONS
Re-Advertisement for Category D**

The California Gambling Control Commission's Gaming Policy Advisory Committee (GPAC) had five members whose term is set to expire on December 31, 2018. Per the current Selection Process, the Commission advertised between September 11, 2018 and November 16, 2018 for applications to fill the following five categories:

1. **Category A:** An employee from the Bureau of Gambling Control (BGC), Department of Justice (one seat)
2. **Category B:** A representative from an agency or nonprofit concerned with problem gambling and/or gambling addiction (one seat)
3. **Category D:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with 25 tables or more in operation (Two seats on GPAC; one seat expiring)
4. **Category E:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with less than 25 tables in operation (Two seats on GPAC; one seat expiring)
5. **Category F:** A representative affiliated with local law enforcement from a local government where an approved ordinance allows legalized gaming (one seat)

Interviews were conducted and on December 13, 2018 the Commissioners approved the appointment of committee members for categories A, B, E, and F. However, the Commission did not receive any applications for consideration for appointment to Category D, which would represent large cardrooms with 25 or more tables.

The Commission is re-advertising the Category D vacancy and will be accepting applications through January 24, 2019. Interviews will be held shortly thereafter with all eligible applicants in hopes of filling the vacancy prior to the first 2019 GPAC meeting.

Members of the Gaming Policy Advisory Committee may serve three (3) consecutive terms of up to two (2) years each.
