CLEAN UP OF REFERENCES TO B&P 19801 CGCC-GCA-2017-06-N

SECTION 100. CHANGES WITHOUT REGULATORY EFFECT

Pursuant to Title 1, Division 1, Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 100(b)(3), of the California Code of Regulations (CCR), the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) hereby submits this written statement explaining why the proposed changes to CCR Title 4, Division 18, Sections 12120, 12303, and 12362,¹ have no regulatory effect.

CHANGES TO TEXT

Section 12120 is amended to revise the Reference of Business and Professions (B&P) Code section 19801, subdivision (j) to subdivision (k). This change only corrects the reference while maintaining existing regulatory authority.

Section 12303 is amended to revise the Authority Cited of B&P Code section 19801, subdivision (g) to subdivision (h). This change only corrects the reference while maintaining existing regulatory requirements.

Section 12362, subsection (a), is amended to revise the reference of B&P Code section 19801, subdivision (i) to subdivision (j). In addition, the Reference of B&P section 19801, subdivisions (i) and (l), are revised to subdivisions (j) and (m), respectively. These changes only correct the references while maintaining existing regulatory requirements and authority.

SPECIFIC FINDINGS

With respect to the foregoing, the Commission finds as follows:

NECESSITY:

Senate Bill 730 (Florez, Chapter 438, Statutes of 2007) made amendments to B&P Code section 19801. These changes included the renumbering of the subdivisions. Without correcting the references to the subdivisions of B&P Code section 19801, these provisions inaccurately report Authority and Reference citations. Additionally, Section 12362, subdivision (a) incorrectly references subdivision (i).

CONSISTENCY:

Without correcting the references to the subdivisions of B&P Code section 19801, these provisions are inconsistent with B&P Code section 19801. By correcting these references, these regulatory provisions will become consistent with B&P Code section 19801.

THE PROPOSED ACTION HAS NO REGULATORY EFFECT

The proposed changes will not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription, or other regulatory element of any CCR provision. These proposed changes simply revise and correct an inadvertent oversight and maintains the original intent of an existing provision.
