

CALIFORNIA GAMBLING CONTROL COMMISSION GAMING POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE NOTIFICATION OF 2020 TERM EXPIRATIONS

The California Gambling Control Commission's Gaming Policy Advisory Committee (GPAC) has five members whose term is set to expire on December 31, 2020. These five members currently occupy the following seats:

1. **Category A:** An employee from the Bureau of Gambling Control (BGC), Department of Justice (one seat)
2. **Category B:** A representative from an agency or nonprofit concerned with problem gambling and/or gambling addiction (one seat)
3. **Category D:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with 25 tables or more in operation (Two seats on GPAC; one seat expiring)
4. **Category E:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with less than 25 tables in operation (Two seats on GPAC; one seat expiring)
5. **Category F:** A representative affiliated with local law enforcement from a local government where an approved ordinance allows legalized gaming (one seat)

Per the current [Selection Process](#), as approved and adopted by the Commissioners on September 12, 2019, the following process for Renewal of Terms shall be followed:

A notification of the expiring terms of GPAC Committee Members will be sent to the Commission's mailing list, and posted on the Commission's website, not less than three (3) months prior to the expiration dates.

Members of the Committee in good standing, who want to remain on the Committee for another term, meet the requirements of the category they were elected to and all other requirements of the GPAC, and who run unopposed in their category, may be recommended to the Commission with a consensus from the GPAC without a formal interview process.

All existing incumbents of the category seats listed above are eligible for reappointment.

Members of the Gaming Policy Advisory Committee may serve three (3) consecutive terms of up to two (2) years each on a respective Category seat. The Commission will accept applications from anyone who is eligible and wishes to be considered for appointment to any of the seats identified above until **Tuesday, December 8, 2020**. Interviews will be scheduled shortly thereafter. Appointment recommendations will be considered by the Commission at a public meeting in December or January.
