

CALIFORNIA GAMBLING CONTROL COMMISSION GAMING POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE NOTIFICATION OF 2021 TERM EXPIRATIONS

The California Gambling Control Commission's Gaming Policy Advisory Committee (GPAC) has five members whose term is set to expire on December 31, 2021. These are the five seats with a December 31, 2021 term expiration:

1. **Category C:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a Third Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (One seat expiring)¹
2. **Category D:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with 25 tables or more in operation (Two seats on GPAC; One seat expiring)
3. **Category E:** A licensee, agent, or employee from a cardroom with less than 25 tables in operation (Two seats on GPAC; One seat expiring)
4. **Category G:** A professional with accounting or business background and not affiliated with CA legalized gambling entity (One seat expiring)
5. **Category H:** General member at large not currently affiliated with any CA legalized gambling entity (One seat expiring)

Per the current [Selection Process](#), as approved and adopted by the Commissioners on September 12, 2019, the following process for Renewal of Terms shall be followed:

A notification of the expiring terms of GPAC Committee Members will be sent to the Commission's mailing list, and posted on the Commission's website, not less than three (3) months prior to the expiration dates.

Members of the Committee in good standing, who want to remain on the Committee for another term, meet the requirements of the category they were elected to and all other requirements of the GPAC, and who run unopposed in their category, may be recommended to the Commission with a consensus from the GPAC without a formal interview process.

Members of the Gaming Policy Advisory Committee may serve three (3) consecutive terms of up to two (2) years each on a respective Category seat. The Commission will accept applications from anyone who is eligible and wishes to be considered for appointment to those seats with an upcoming term expiration, as identified above, until **Friday, November 5, 2021**. Interviews will be scheduled shortly thereafter. Appointment recommendations will be considered by the Commission at a public meeting in December.
