

Resolution Concerning Delegation of Authority in Rulemaking

It is hereby resolved on February 23, 2021, by the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) that:

- **Paula LaBrie**, Chair;
- **Stacey Luna Baxter**, Executive Director;
- **R. Todd Vlaanderen**, Chief Counsel; and,
- **Adrianna Alcalá-Beshara**, Deputy Director of Legislative and Regulatory Affairs

are each individually authorized to:

1. Sign certifications required by Government Code section 11343, pursuant to Government Code section 11343(g);
2. Sign all other forms required to obtain approval of regulations submitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL);
3. Make nonsubstantive changes during the OAL review period to any filing submitted to OAL;
4. Prior to a Commission meeting for the approval of an emergency regulatory action, prepare and file with OAL the notice of proposed emergency regulatory action, proposed regulation text, and the finding of emergency;
5. Submit to OAL for re-adoption pursuant to Government Code section 11346.1(h), provided that the filing consists solely of emergency regulations previously approved by the Commission, the text of which has not been substantively changed;
6. Prepare and file with OAL notices of a decision not to proceed with a rulemaking action, pursuant to Government Code section 11347; and,
7. Approve the annual rulemaking calendar required by Government Code section 11017.6 and to submit that calendar to OAL for publication in the California Regulatory Notice Register.
