Re: **Commission Public Meetings Conducted in Zoom Only Effective July 15, 2022**

As noticed in the California Gambling Control Commission's (Commission) Industry Notice dated March 18, 2022, the Commission has been conducting all public meetings in-person. At times, the Commission operated up to three public meeting locations (Sacramento/Headquarters, San Francisco, and Los Angeles) simultaneously in order to ensure compliance with the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act (Act), which requires the Commission to provide an in-person location for all public meetings, and notice the location of all participating Commissioners, in addition to other requirements.

Although not required, in addition to the required in-person locations, the Commission provided the benefit and flexibility of participating in all public meetings via Zoom in lieu of attending in-person.

On June 30, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom signed [Senate Bill \(SB\) 189](#), which added Section 11133 of the Government Code, providing immediate temporary relief through June 30, 2023, to the existing in-person and noticing Act requirements. As such, effective July 15, 2022¹, the Commission will operate its public meetings solely via Zoom through June 2023.
