

12 § 12054. Consideration at a Commission Meeting.

13 (a) At a Commission meeting, the Commission may take, but is not limited to taking, one of the
14 following actions:

15 ...

16 (6) Extend a cardroom category license, TPPPS category license, registration, or finding of suitability
17 for up to 180 calendar days, as necessary, if an applicant has submitted their renewal application prior to
18 the original expiration date of the current license, Commission work permit, registration, or finding of
19 suitability, and the Commission is unable to act on the application prior to the expiration date as provided
20 in Business and Professions Code section 19876, subdivision (c).
