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7 **CHAPTER 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

8 **ARTICLE 1. DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL PROCEDURES**

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10 **§ 12002. General Definitions.**

11 Unless otherwise specified, the definitions in Business and Professions Code section 19805,  
12 supplemented by the definitions found in Chapter 10 of Title 9 of Part 1 of the Penal Code (commencing  
13 with section 330), govern the construction of this division. As used in this division:

15 (ab) "Gross revenue" means the total of all compensation received for participating in or conducting  
16 any controlled game, and includes interest received in payment for credit extended by a cardroom  
17 business licensee to a patron for purposes of gambling.

### 11 **CHAPTER 3. CONDITIONS OF OPERATION FOR TPPPS BUSINESSES**

#### 12 **ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

##### 13 **§ 12252. TPPPS Annual Fee.**

14 (a) The Bureau will provide each TPPPS business licensee an invoice, pursuant to Section 12006, by  
15 October 1, 2022, and each October 1 thereafter, of their annual fee, as provided in Section 12252.2.

16 (b) The annual fee may be paid in installments. The TPPPS business licensee must submit a written  
17 request to the Bureau to make installment payments within 30 calendar days from the date the invoice  
18 was served.

19 (c) A request for installment payments will be considered approved, unless within 14 calendar days of  
20 the request being received, the Bureau provides notification, pursuant to Section 12006, that the request  
21 has been disapproved. The Bureau will disapprove the request if the TPPPS business licensee has a  
22 history of failing to make installment payments as required or has not submitted the request pursuant to  
23 subsection (b). Installment payments must be made in the year following the request pursuant to  
24 subsection (b) as follows: one-third of the annual fee to be submitted no later than January 1, one-third no  
25 later than April 1, and the balance no later than June 30. If installment payments were not requested or a  
26 request for installment payments was disapproved, the entire amount of the annual fee must be submitted  
27 no later than January 1.

28 (d) The TPPPS license certificate will not be issued until the Bureau has received the annual fee or  
29 has approved the TPPPS business licensee for installment payments.

30 (e) Any application for a renewal TPPPS business license will not be approved by the Commission  
31 until any delinquent annual fees have been paid in full.

32 (f) No application for a TPPPS contract may be approved by the Bureau until any delinquent annual  
33 fees have been paid in full.

(g)(1) Upon the first issuance of a TPPPS business license, as either a temporary TPPPS business license or an initial TPPPS business license, whichever occurs first, the Bureau will issue an invoice, pursuant to Section 12006, in the annual fee amount required of an active licensee with a gross revenue under \$1,500,000, as provided in Section 12252.2, divided by 12, multiplied by the number of whole months remaining in the current calendar year. The TPPPS business licensee must submit to the Bureau the annual fee within 30 calendar days of service.

(2) For the first full calendar year of licensure, the Bureau will invoice, pursuant to Section 12006, the TPPPS business licensee the unadjusted annual fee required of an active licensee with a gross revenue under \$1,500,000, as provided in Section 12252.2 for the following calendar year. If the license is approved after October 1, this invoice will be issued at the same time as the invoice required in paragraph (1).

Surrendered or Revoked Licensee	\$0
Non-Operational Licensee	\$2,035
Active Licensee – 3-Year Average Gross Revenue Under \$1.5M	\$4,069
Active Licensee – 3-Year Average Gross Revenue of \$1.5M or More	1.54% of the 3-year Average Gross Revenue
