



ADVISORY NOTICE

APPROVAL OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS COMMISSION FEES MODERNIZATION PROJECT III

(CGCC-GCA-2022-03-EEE)

On December 23, 2022, the Office of Administrative Law approved emergency regulations which readopted the California Gambling Control Commission's (Commission) regulations providing annual fee calculations for cardroom business licensees without further amendment. The approved regulations were filed with the Secretary of State on December 23, 2022, and became effective on December 30, 2022. The second re-adoption of these emergency regulations will remain in effect for 90 days and is currently set to expire on April 3, 2023. The Commission does intend to make these emergency regulatory changes permanent and is taking the steps necessary to pursue permanency via the certificate of compliance process.

Approved Regulations

This proposed re-adoption maintains the existing emergency regulation without modification or amendment. Sections 12002, 12252, 12252.2 were removed from the emergency filing as they were permanently adopted as part of another rulemaking action, OAL Matter Number 2022-1021-06SR.
