12 § 12290. Compliance.

13 (a) A TPPPS licensee must comply with game rules approved by the Bureau, including but not
14 limited to the rules regarding player-dealer rotation and table wagering.

15 (b) Only an authorized player may possess, direct, or otherwise control currency, chips, or other
16 wagering instruments used for play in the performance of a TPPPS contract.

17 (c) The ~~TPPPSeardroom~~ business licensee must notify the Bureau within five calendar days of the
18 following incidents:

19 (1) An electronic playing book device, system, or database failure that prevents it from functioning as
20 initially approved.

21 (2) Impermissible use or access to the electronic playing book device system.

22 (3) Failure of the electronic playing book database to synchronize information from the electronic
23 playing book device for a period longer than 24 hours.

24 (d) A TPPPS contract may, concerning any table assigned for play by the contracted TPPPS business
25 licensee, contain a provision precluding players of any other TPPPS business licensee from playing at that
26 table during the periods of play assigned by the TPPPS contract for the contracted TPPPS business
27 licensee.

28 (e) The cardroom business licensee is not precluded from assigning a seat at the table to a TPPPS
29 business licensee.
