Addendum to Final Statement of Reasons

Initial Fee for State Gambling License

Proposed Title 4 CCR section 12341

Business and Professions Code section 19951(g) provides:

"It is the intent of the Legislature that the fees paid pursuant to this section are sufficient to enable the division and the commission to fully carry out their duties and responsibilities under this chapter."

The amounts chosen for the fees specified in section 12341 for initial issuance of a state gambling license provide the funding necessary to permit the Division of Gambling Control and the California Gambling Control Commission to carry out their duties and responsibilities under the Gambling Control Act concerning applicants for and holders of initial state gambling licenses. Further, the amounts chosen are identical to the statutory amounts for a renewal or provisional state gambling license because the Commission has determined that the processing and other associated costs are essentially the same.
