

Updated Informative Digest

No changes to be made. The Informative Digest in the Initial Statement of Reasons is incorporated as if fully set forth in this section.

Final Statement of Reasons

The Final Statement of Reasons is separated into two parts. Part A updates the Initial Statement of Reasons and Part B summarizes and responds to comments made during the formal 45-day comment period. No comments were received during the public hearing on February 18, 2004. No comments were received during the 15-day comment period.

Part A: Update of Initial Statement of Reasons

Except as noted below, the Initial Statement of Reasons is incorporated as if fully set forth in this section. ~~The section noticed as 12250, "License Renewals" has been nonsubstantively renumbered to 12344 with a clarified chapter heading of Chapter 6, State Gambling Licenses for Gambling Establishments.~~ From the original text, License Renewals was amended based upon comments received (see Part B), to clarify that applications, although submitted for separate individuals, are to be submitted in a joint package, and to clarify that any money for further background investigations will be requested only when determined necessary. The amendments also clarify which forms are required for a license renewal.

REQUIRED DETERMINATIONS
