- Independent state agency.
- Develops regulations and sets policy.
- Issues or denies gaming licenses to cardroom or Third-Party Provider workers and owners at biweekly public meetings.
- Considers suitability of tribal casino management, vendors, and financial sources.
- Administers Revenue Sharing Trust Fund for gaming and non-gaming California tribes.

Department of Justice, Bureau of Gambling Control



- Under the Attorney General.
- Investigations and enforcement of gaming laws and regulations.
- Conducts background investigations into:
 - Cardroom workers and owners;
 - Third-Party Provider workers and owners;
 - Tribal casino management, vendors, and financial sources.
- Conducts tribal financial audits, electronic gaming device inspections, compliance reviews.
