**MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 8, 2007  
COMMISSION MEETING**

---

**OPEN SESSION**

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Shelton called the meeting to order at 1:45 p.m., and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call of Commissioners.

Roll Call of Commissioners was taken with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich present.

Chairman Shelton introduced recently appointed Commissioner Sheryl Schmidt.

3. Approval of Commission Meeting Minutes for October 11, 2007.

Upon motion of Chairman Shelton to approve the October 11, 2007 Commission meeting minutes, seconded by Commissioner Shimazu and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, Commissioner Schmidt abstaining, the Commission adopted the October 11, 2007 minutes.

4. Request for Approval of Amended Articles of Incorporation (Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 19881): Club One Casino, Inc.

Senior Legal Counsel Bolz indicated that staff recommended that the Commission approve the amended articles of incorporation for Club One Casino, Inc. Upon motion of Commissioner Shimazu, seconded by Commissioner Vuksich and unanimously

carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

5. Applications for Renewal of State Gambling License Including All Associated Applicants and Endorsees (Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 19876):

- A. Empire Sportsmen's Association: Empire Sportsmen's Association, a Non-Profit Corporation

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that staff recommended that the Commission extend the renewal license for the period of December 1, 2007 through April 30, 2008 with the following key employees: Que Huynh and Savon Pek. Staff also recommended that the following condition be continued:

The licensee shall, at licensee's cost and expense, do the following:

- Authorize, direct and empower a certified public accountant selected by the Bureau and Commission from the list provided to them by licensee to meet with representative of the Bureau from time to time and as requested, to cooperate fully and timely with the Bureau in conducting a review and inspection of licensee's books and records, including its income tax returns, as well as those of its officers and directors, in accordance with the instructions and protocol set forth by Bureau, and to render to the Bureau timely a written report specifying in detail the results of the review and inspection of the books and records.

Staff further recommended that the following two conditions be removed:

- The license is conditioned upon the local gambling ordinance coming into compliance with the Gambling Control Act (Business and Professions Code section 197860(a)(4)) within 12 months of issuance/renewal.
- Within 30 days, provide to the Bureau and Commission a list showing the names, addresses and telephone number(s) of at least two certified public accountants who are duly licensed and in good standing in the State of California and, by virtue of their experience in auditing non-profit entities, are acceptable to the Division for the purpose of conducting, at the direction of the Commission, a review and inspection of licensee's books and records, including licensee's income tax returns, as well as those of its officers and directors.

Upon motion of Commissioner Vuksich, seconded by Commissioner Shimazu and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

- B. Lucky Derby Casino: Point Walker, Inc.

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that staff recommended that the Commission approve the renewal license for the period of December 1, 2007 through July 31, 2008 with the

following key employees: Roger Ankenbauer, Leslie Boyer, William Crowe, Dennis Glasco, Donald Schayltz, Roger Sadauskas and San Kuen. Upon motion of Commissioner Shimazu, seconded by Commissioner Vuksich and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

C. Mortimer's Card Room: Mortimer's, Inc.

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that staff recommended that the Commission approve the renewal license for the period of December 1, 2007 through April 30, 2009 with the following key employees: Michiko Barratt, Thomas De Courdres, George Freese, Verachia Jongiaroenroongroche, Veronica Lombardi, Marylee Sakas, and Touraj Tehrany. Staff also recommended that the following condition be placed on the license:

1. Charles Kwon, Willis Hanna and Marylee Sakas must submit applications for a state gambling license within 90 days of November 30, 2007.
2. This license is conditioned upon the local gambling ordinance coming into compliance with the Gambling Control Act (Business and Professions Code sections 19860(a)(1) and 19860(a)(5)) within 12 months of issuance/renewal.

Upon motion of Chairman Shelton, seconded by Commissioner Vuksich and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

D. Ocean's Eleven Casino: Ocean's Eleven Casino, a General Partnership

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that staff recommends that the Commission approve the renewal license for the period December 1, 2007 through February 28, 2009 with the shareholders and key employees provided on the list which has been incorporated into these minutes as Attachment A. Upon motion of Commissioner Vuksich, seconded by Commissioner Shimazu and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

SUBJECT: Revenue Sharing Trust Fund Report of Distribution of Funds to Non-Compact Tribes (Eligible Recipient Indian Tribes) for the Quarter Ended September 30, 2007

All eligible tribes will receive a total of \$275,000, which consists of \$102,713.24 from license fees and interest income and \$172,286.76 from shortfall funds that have been transferred into RSTF from SDF as shown in Exhibit 1. The quarterly amount of the shortfall in payments to all eligible recipient Indian tribes for the quarter totals \$12,232,359.96. A portion of the interest earned is allocated to previously approved distributions held in RSTF on behalf of one (1) tribe in the amount of \$35,442.96.

The total amount of quarterly license fee payments and interest received into the RSTF for the quarterly period ended September 30, 2007, is approximately \$7.32 million. License fees approximate \$6.93 million and interest of \$397,478.94 was received in July 2007. A listing of the amount of revenue received from each Compact Tribe is attached as Exhibit 3. The receipts are equally distributed to the seventy-one (71)\* tribes listed in Exhibit 1 as eligible Non-Compact recipient tribes (pending receipt of outstanding eligibility certification forms, if any).

At the end of the calendar quarter, the amount of outstanding license fee payments due into the RSTF from four (4) tribes was \$791,912.50. If the total license fee payments due at the end of this quarter had been paid into the RSTF, each recipient tribe would have received \$11,153.69 in additional RSTF money with this quarter's distribution in lieu of an equal amount of SDF transferred shortfall funds. Total outstanding and due license fee payments for the quarter ended September 30, 2007, are summarized in Table 1 below:
