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**MINUTES OF MAY 28, 2008  
COMMISSION MEETING**

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**OPEN SESSION**

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Shelton called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m., and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call of Commissioners.

Roll Call of Commissioners was taken with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich present.

3. Approval of Commission Meeting Minutes:
  - A. April 22, 2008

Upon motion of Commissioner Schmidt, seconded by Commissioner Shimazu and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the April 22, 2008 Commission meeting minutes.

4. Request for Approval of Articles of Incorporation (Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 19881):

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that Item 4 was being removed from the agenda because the applicant had withdrawn his request to incorporate the cardroom.

5. Request for Approval of Sale of Existing Gambling Establishment (Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 19824(c): Don Juan Club and Casino

Commission consideration of agenda Item 5 followed Item 16 and preceded the Consent Calendar.

Commission consideration of agenda Item 6.A. followed Item 16 and preceded the Consent Calendar.

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that Commission staff recommended that the Commission approve Ernest Schmidt and Julie Baron to be endorsed on the initial state gambling license for Casino Real, Inc., Item 6.B., for the period of June 1, 2008, through November 30, 2009. Deputy Director Ciau further indicated that Casino Real, Inc.'s state gambling license would be on the agenda for renewal at the June 26, 2008 meeting. Upon motion of Commissioner Shimazu, seconded by Commissioner Schmidt and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that staff recommended that the Commission approve the initial state gambling license for Central Coast Casino, Item 6.C., for the period of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008. Deputy Director Ciau further indicated that the renewal application would be scheduled for the June 26 Commission meeting.

David Stearns provided comments in response to concerns raised by Commissioners Schmidt and Vuksich regarding letters of warning and notices of violation that were issued to the applicant by the Bureau.

Norm Pierce, Bureau of Gambling Control, responded to the Commission's concerns regarding whether the Commission would be provided with the responses to notices of violations and warning letters issued by the Bureau. Mr. Pierce indicated that for instances where there may be a pending administrative action the Bureau has been advised by counsel not to divulge any information that might jeopardize any administrative action.

Chairman Shelton moved to approve the applicant's request. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Vuksich and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes.

Additionally, staff recommended that the Commission approve the renewal state gambling license for the same licensure period with the key employees listed in Attachment A to the minutes. Upon motion of Commissioner Vuksich, seconded by Commissioner Shimazu and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

Deputy Director Ciau indicated that staff recommended that the Commission approve applicant Maile Bridge's endorsement on the initial state gambling license for Village Club, Item 6.G., for the period of January 1, 2008, through August 31, 2009.

Rod Blonien responded to concerns raised by Chairman Shelton regarding the rent increase and indicated that the increase was based on fair market value.

Upon motion of Commissioner Shimazu, seconded by Chairman Shelton and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

Francis Asuncion, Bureau of Gambling Control, presented comments regarding the Bureau's investigation of previous violations of the cardroom and indicated that the Bureau had received a response from the cardroom and that the case is now closed and there are presently no outstanding issues.

Upon motion of Commissioner Shimazu, seconded by Commissioner Vuksich and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Schmidt, Shimazu, and Vuksich voting yes, the Commission adopted the staff recommendation.

Susan Barrows presented comments to the Commission requesting that she be privy to Bureau information regarding the pending sale of the cardroom.

Norm Pierce responded to Commissioner Shimazu's question on whether a three-month extension of the license would be adequate for the Bureau to complete its investigation process. Mr. Pierce indicated that the Bureau anticipates providing the Commission with its complete report within the next three weeks.
