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**MINUTES OF APRIL 28, 2010
COMMISSION MEETING**

OPEN SESSION

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Dean Shelton called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m., and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call of Commissioners.

Roll Call of Commissioners was taken, with Chairman Dean Shelton and Commissioners James Shelby and Stephanie Shimazu present.

3. Application for Approval for Initial State Gambling License (Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 19851):

A. Casino Royale: Sacramento Grand Casino, LLC

Deputy Director Tina Littleton indicated that staff recommended the Commission approve the initial state gambling license applications for the period of April 28, 2010 through April 30, 2012.

James Kouretas responded to questions from Commissioner Shimazu seeking confirmation that his financial reports will be submitted by April 30, 2010. He indicated that he would use his best effort to have financial statements provided on time. When asked about the personal loans he acquired from a James Stadler, he further indicated that he was working on accelerating payment on these loans which were needed for capital for construction because at the time he was experiencing a liquidity crunch.

Chairman Shelton expressed his displeasure of the loans between Mr. Kouretas and a minority owner of the Third Party Provider of Proposition Player Services, who is the contract provider for the cardroom.

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Chairman Shelton advised Mr. Kouretas to get the loans paid and sever the financial relationship with Mr. Stadler. Chairman Shelton further indicated his uneasiness with the non-disclosure, by the Bureau of Gambling Control, of the content of the confidential settlement received by Mr. Blanas. Chairman Shelton expressed that as the licensing agency, the Commission should be able to have knowledge of the financial status of a person who is purchasing a share of a gambling establishment.

Vrej Sarkissian, Auditor with the Bureau of Gambling Control indicated the Bureau was told the content of the settlement was confidential by the applicant. Mr. Sarkissian also indicated that the Bureau is aware of the amount of the settlement and if the parties agreed, he would disclose it to the Commission.

Commissioner Shelby indicated that the Commission by law is a confidential body, and was concerned that the Bureau of Gambling Control could not disclose the information in the report.

Chairman Shelton requested Mr. Blanas' attorney put the information in a confidential form and forward it to the Commission for review.

Upon motion of Chairman Shelton, seconded by Commissioner Shimazu and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Shelby and Shimazu voting yes, the Commission approved the staff recommendation.

Deputy Director Tina Littleton indicated that staff recommended the Commission approve the initial state gambling license application for Alicia Gomez Buck to be endorsed on Tommy's Casino and Saloon state gambling license.

Upon motion of Commissioner Shelby, seconded by Commissioner Shimazu and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Shelton and Commissioners Shelby and Shimazu voting yes, the Commission approved the staff recommendation.

All eligible Tribes will receive a total of \$275,000.00, which consists of \$173,013.95 from license fees and interest income and \$101,986.05 from shortfall funds that have been transferred into RSTF from SDF as shown in Exhibit 1. The quarterly amount of the shortfall in payments to all eligible recipient Indian Tribes for the quarter totals \$7,241,009.55. A portion of the interest earned is allocated to previously approved distributions held in RSTF on behalf of one (1) Tribe in the amount of \$7,297.66.

The total amount of quarterly license fee payments and interest received into the RSTF for the quarterly period ended March 31, 2010, is approximately \$12.29 million. License fees approximate \$12.22 million and interest of \$69,462.42 was received in February 2010.

The distribution to the Alturas Indian Rancheria, California Valley Miwok Tribe, and the Death Valley Timbi-Sha Shoshone Band of California for the quarter ended March 31, 2010 is withheld in the RSTF until their respective Tribal government is identified.

Wilton Rancheria has identified their Tribal government. A distribution to them will be made for this quarter. However, distributions and revisions for prior quarters "RSTF Report of Distribution of Funds" may be necessary to adjust for the Wilton Rancheria's beginning distribution date.

A listing of the amount of revenue received from each Compact Tribe is attached as Exhibit 3. The receipts are equally distributed to seventy-one (71)¹ of the eighty-seven (87) Tribes listed in Exhibit 1 as eligible recipient Tribes (pending receipt of outstanding eligibility certification forms, if any).

At the end of the calendar quarter, the amount of outstanding license fee payments due into the RSTF from one (1) Tribe was \$35,302.20. If the total license fee payments due at the end of this quarter had been paid into the RSTF, each recipient Tribe would have received \$497.21 in additional RSTF money with this quarter's distribution in lieu of an equal amount of SDF transferred shortfall funds. Total outstanding and due license fee payments for the quarter ended March 31, 2010, are summarized in the following Table 1:
