- 2. The CFO must approve and sign any transaction of \$50,000 or more.
- 3. The Bureau of Gambling Control and California Gambling Control Commission will be notified of any amended tax return filings or audits of Dolchee, LLC, Profitable Casino, LLC, Garden City, Inc. (dba Casino M8trix) and Eric Swallow.
- 4. LAX shall provide the Bureau of Gambling Control with a report regarding the employment of employees previously employed by Century Gaming Management. The report will provide information regarding the diversity of the workforce.
