Remove Condition:

 Within 30 days, state gambling license applications and required fees must be submitted to the Bureau of Gambling Control (Bureau) from Normandie Club, L.P. and Normandie Club, Inc., and associated shareholders. In addition, a transaction document must be submitted to the Bureau which transfers ownership interest from Normandie Club, A General Partnership to Normandie Club, L.P. and Normandie Club, Inc., subject to approval by the Commission.

Note: Commission staff is recommending removal of this condition as it has been met. The applications for Normandie Club, L.P. and Normandie Club, Inc. were received by the Bureau on September 24, 2013, and the applications for Lauren E. Cole, Gregory L. Miller, Lawrence F. Miller, Matthew S. Miller, Russell L. Miller, Jr., and Stephen A. Miller were received on December 26, 2013 and are currently pending background investigation.

Continue and Amend Conditions:

- 2. Beginning December 1, 2013, and on a monthly basis thereafter, The Normandie Club shall <u>continue to</u> submit to the Bureau of Gambling Control monthly a detail accounting demonstrating adequate financial backing for all chips in use.
- 3. Beginning December 1, 2013, The Normandie Club shall <u>continue to</u> maintain a compliance committee that includes the following:
- a. An outside member that is from a certified public accounting business with experience in controlled gambling in the State of California
- b. An outside member that has demonstrable credentials and experience in California gaming law
- 4. The compliance committee, as noted in Condition 2, shall <u>continue</u> to meet monthly. The committee's responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to, the following:
- a. Inspection of all background reports on licensing applications
- b. Approval of Normandie Club's credit policy
- c. Analysis of credit aging
- d. Review of litigation
- e. Review of the termination and discipline of management personnel
- f. Review of any exception in variance reports over \$500 in a single transaction and \$1,000 monthly
- g. Review of any policy and procedure changes
- Agreement to any contracts, agreements, and transactions of \$10,000 or more, not including chip transactions
- i. Review of the Currency Transaction Reports, Suspicious Activity Reports, daily logs, internal audit reports, or any other internal or external reports from the previous month that address potential failures in the internal control systems and any real or potential compliance issues related to the statutes and regulations governing controlled gambling in the State of California.
- 5. The Normandie Club shall continue to retain a consultant with demonstrable credentials in the policies and procedures governing the operation of California or Asian games. Further, the consultant shall spend a minimum of 30 hours per week observing the operation of these games and provide a written report to the compliance committee and to the Bureau of Gambling Control recording the following:
- a. Any witnessed violations of The Normandie Club's existing policies and procedures.
- b. Any recommended changes to The Normandie Club's policies and procedures.

- c. Any unusual or suspicious circumstances concerning the operation of the facility.
- Note: Designated Agent Tracey Buck-Walsh had requested to modify this condition to change the hours the consultant shall spend observing the operation from 30 hours per week to 30 hours per month. The Bureau reviewed this request and informed Commission staff that they recommend that this condition not be changed. Staff concurs with the Bureau's recommendation; and, recommended that this condition not be amended until final resolution of the pending accusation.
- 6. The Normandie Club's senior surveillance officer shall have direct line reporting to the Board of Directors (Board), which may be a subcommittee of the Board or a designated member of the Board. Further, the surveillance officer shall have dotted line reporting to the operations management.
