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MINUTES OF MAY 14, 2015 COMMISSION MEETING

OPEN SESSION

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Lopes called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call of Commissioners.

Roll Call of Commissioners was taken, with Chairman Richard Lopes and Commissioners Tiffany Conklin, Lauren Hammond and Richard Schuetz present.

- 2. Issuance of an <u>interim gambling</u> license does not prejudice or obligate the Commission to grant a regular gambling license. Issuance of a regular gambling license is subject to the results of a complete background

- investigation by the Bureau, the conduct of the applicant during the term of the interim gambling license, and final approval of the Commission pursuant to Sections 12342 and 12346.
- 3. Issuance of this <u>interim gambling</u> license does not in any way change the legal requirement that the applicant bears the burden of establishing that he/she is suitable pursuant to Business and Professions (B&P) Code section 19856(a) for a regular license.
- 4. Issuance of this <u>interim gambling</u> license does not change the license qualification requirements of the Gambling Control Act, including but not limited to B&P Code sections 19856, 19857, 19858, and 19859.
- 5. The holder of an <u>interim gambling</u> license shall provide the Bureau with the name of any newly-appointed key employee within 30 days following the appointment of that key employee. Within 30 days of its occurrence, the holder of an interim gambling license shall also provide the Bureau with the name of any person who provides any service or property to the gambling enterprise under any arrangement whereby the person receives payment based on the earnings, profits or receipts of the gambling enterprise.
- 6. The holder of an <u>interim gambling</u> license shall pay all applicable annual fees associated with a regular gambling license.
- 7. The holder of an <u>interim gambling</u> license shall comply with the provisions of the Act, this division and Title 11, Division 3, of the California Code of Regulations.
- 8. During the term of an <u>interim gambling</u> license, any proceeds derived from the operation of the gambling enterprise that would otherwise be payable to a new owner shall be held in an escrow account and not disbursed until the disposition of ownership interest has been resolved and received Commission approval and all owners of the gambling enterprise have been approved by the Commission for a regular gambling license pursuant to Section 12342. This paragraph shall not prevent the payment of any taxes, operating expenses, preexisting obligations, preexisting dependent support or any other distribution of proceeds that is approved by the Commission.
- 9. If, during the term of the <u>interim gambling</u> license, the Executive Director determines that any particular applicant is disqualified for any of the reasons set forth in B&P Code section 19859, or may have violated one or more of the conditions under which the <u>interim gambling</u> license was issued, the Executive Director shall prepare and serve on the license holder an order to show cause as to why the <u>interim gambling</u> license should not be cancelled. The holder of the <u>interim gambling</u> license shall be given 30 days to respond in writing. After receipt of the license holder's response, or if the license holder fails to respond within the specified time, the matter shall be set for consideration at a noticed Commission meeting. The interim license holder

may address the Commission by way of an oral or written statement, or both, at the Commission meeting. If the Commission acts to cancel the <u>interim</u> <u>gambling</u> license, the license holder may request an evidentiary hearing, in writing, either at that meeting or within 10 calendar days following that meeting.
