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**MINUTES OF JUNE 8, 2017
COMMISSION MEETING**

OPEN SESSION

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner LaBrie expressed concern about the proximity in time from Mr. Thomas conviction. Commission LaBrie asked Mr. Thomas if part of his sentence included an anger management class. Mr. Thomas responded that the initial evaluation was to determine if Mr. Thomas had anger management issues, however the initial evaluation revealed that he had more of a problem with alcohol and substance abuse issues so he was ordered "sobriety" for nine months, however no anger management was ordered. Mr. Thomas further elaborated he was court-tested for alcohol and opiate narcotics wherein all tests came back satisfactory. Commissioner To asked how he was at the hearing today. Mr. Thomas responded he was fine and dealt with "a lot of it" over the last year. Mr. Thomas admitted it was a horrible action that he did, but he has taken ownership of his actions and understands there are consequences to his actions. Mr. Thomas further stated that he took himself out of leadership roles as he understood that it was not something that he was ready for, and has returned to card dealing which is something he states he enjoys. Commissioner To asked if he is using any alcohol or illegal substances. Mr. Thomas responded that he is not, and he had "never really been big into those in the first place".

Commissioner Hammond expressed concern, and stated that while she appreciated the progress Mr. Thomas has made, she did not believe he was ready for his permit. Chairman Evans concurred and stated that as this matter involved issues of potential violence at work, but also substance abuse and as such more information is needed which is why he rather supported an evidentiary hearing.
