#### MINUTES OF JUNE 22, 2017 COMMISSION MEETING

### **OPEN SESSION**

Commissioner LaBrie specified that she preferred the option for approval with the condition. Mr. Williams stated that he would like to have the option to cash his payroll checks at the Casino Real and did not understand the rationale for the condition. Commissioner LaBrie asked the Commission staff to provide background as to why

the condition was provided as an option. Commission Licensing Division Deputy Director Alcala-Beshara referenced that in the Bureau's report it was notated that a well-defined picture of Mr. Williams's financials was not easily obtained as Mr. Williams cashes his payroll checks at the cardroom, and the option with the condition was provided to allow for a clearer assessment of Mr. Williams's financials in the future. Bureau Assistant Director Morrow confirmed that due to the cashing of the checks it was difficult to ascertain a clear financial picture. Bureau Senior Management Auditor York confirmed that the circumstances regarding the check cashing were notated as a concern. Following the aforementioned discussion, Mr. Williams confirmed he understood and accepted the condition.

Commission Staff Attorney III Jason Pope ("Commission Counsel Pope") provided the procedural history in regards to the current applications pending before the Commission. Commission Counsel Pope discussed that the Applications for Otho Smith and S&K Cardroom were referred to an evidentiary hearing on January 26, 2017. On February 2, 2017, Commission staff endeavored to notify Mr. Smith of the referral and included a Notice of Defense form instructing Mr. Smith to return the form if he wished to participate in the hearing. Commission staff did not receive the returned Notice of Defense form. On March 21, 2017, another Notice of Hearing was sent, and in that notice, specifically informed Mr. Smith of this current hearing. Again, Commission staff did not receive a response. Commission Counsel Pope discussed the default decision that was subsequently drafted for the Commissioners' signatures. Commission Counsel Pope explained that the Default Decision findings state that Mr. Smith has failed to meet his burden to prove his suitability for licensure.
