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# MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 8, 2018 COMMISSION MEETING

### OPEN SESSION

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call of Commissioners.

Roll Call of Commissioners was taken with Chairman Jim Evans, Commissioner Paula LaBrie, and Commissioner Trang To present.

Commissioner To made a motion to approve the Initial Key Employee License and Commissioner LaBrie seconded.

Chairman Evans inquired regarding the circumstances in which the Bureau was unable to ascertain how Mr. Murphy violated casino policies.

Assistant Director Morrow responded that Lucky Chances Casino did not identify the specific policies that Mr. Murphy violated.

Mr. Murphy stated that he had no comment.

Chairman Evans requested the Bureau follow up with Lucky Chances Casino to attempt to ascertain the circumstances. Assistant Director Morrow confirmed that the Bureau would follow up with Lucky Chances.

Commissioner To and Commissioner LaBrie withdrew their motions in order to have the Bureau obtain more information regarding the specific policies that the Cardroom had previously notated that Mr. Murphy violated.

Chairman Evans noted that the crime committed was serious and also acknowledged the age of the crime. Chairman Evans further stated that he found the applicant's statement credible.

Commissioner LaBrie concurred with Chairman Evans and also noted there were no subsequent criminal convictions or derogatory events since the date of conviction.

Assistant Director Morrow verified that the Bureau was unable to obtain a police report to either confirm or contradict Ms. Magtoto's statement.

Commissioner LaBrie asked Ms. Carmona about the status of her driver's license.

Ms. Carmona responded that she has a driver's permit, has taken the written driver's test, and is waiting for an appointment to take the behind the wheel test.

Commissioner LaBrie then asked Ms. Carmona how she has been getting to and from work. Ms. Carmona responded that she drives to and from work when she does not have a ride.

Chairman Evans asked Ms. Carmona if a permit allows her to drive alone. Ms. Carmona responded that a permit requires she drives with someone.

Commissioner To asked Ms. Carmona if she drives with someone or if she drives alone. Ms. Carmona responded that she does not drive with someone all the time and sometimes drives to work alone.

Chairman Evans asked Ms. Carmona if she were granted a license as a condition would she agree not to drive without a licensed driver in the car while she only has a permit and not a license. Ms. Carmona responded that she would agree to that condition.

Commissioner To stated that while he acknowledges and appreciates the Applicant's honesty, he expressed concerns regarding that Ms. Carmona knowingly is violating the law and cannot at this time cannot support an approval if an Applicant knows of the illegality and still choses to do it anyway.

Assistant Director Morrow discussed that a part of the reason for the Bureau's recommendation stems from knowing that there also are laws and regulations that must be followed in cardrooms, and when there is a blatant disregard for the law that is concerning.
