 19882, subdivision (c).
- 2. Additional Legend on Stock Certificate. Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 19904, any purported sale or other disposition of a security issued by a corporate licensee that the Commission did not approve in advance is void. Approval of the transaction contemplated by this transaction is conditioned upon the transferees confirming in writing to the Commission,

with a copy to the Bureau, within 15 days after the transfers that each and every certificate evidencing the shares includes the following legend:

THIS CERTIFICATE REPRESENTS SHARES OF STOCK ISSUED BY A CORPORATION THAT HOLDS A STATE GAMBLING LICENSE PURSUANT TO THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA. THE STOCK MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED, ASSIGNED, SOLD, PLEDGED, HYPOTHECATED, OR DISPOSED OF WITHOUT THE PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE CALIFORNIA GAMBLING CONTROL COMMISSION OR ITS SUCCESSOR.

- 3. Transaction Completed as Approved. Within 15 days after the closing, the transferees shall confirm in writing to the Commission, with a copy to the Bureau, that the transaction has been completed as approved by the Commission.
- 4. Additional Approvals to Enforce Security Interest. In the event that Michael LeBlanc intends to, and does, initiate an action to foreclose upon, or otherwise enforce the security interest asserted against any of the shares held by Mark English pursuant to the Secured Promissory Note and the Stock Pledge Agreement, Michael LeBlanc and Mark English shall notify the Bureau and the Commission of such action, and shall submit an application to the Bureau for approval of the proposed transfer of any proceeds from the operation of K & M Casinos, Inc., or of shares of K & M Casinos, Inc., pursuant to the Secured Promissory Note and/or Stock Pledge Agreement from Mark English to Michael LeBlanc, or to any other party, and such transfers shall be contingent upon the Commission's approval thereof. In the event the underlying dispute giving rise to Michael LeBlanc's right to foreclose upon or otherwise enforce the security interest provided in the Secured Promissory Note and the Stock Pledge Agreement is resolved such that no transfer of the proceeds of the operation of K & M Casinos, Inc., or of the pledged shares of K & M. - 1. This temporary license takes effect on the date that the Commission approves the request and expires on September 30, 2024. This temporary license is not subject to renewal and may be extended only by order of the Commission at its discretion, but in no case shall this temporary license exceed 24 months.
- Issuance of this temporary license does not obligate the Commission to grant a regular license. Issuance of this temporary license does not create a vested right in the holder to either extension of the temporary license or to a regular license.
- Issuance of this temporary license does not change the license qualification requirements of the Gambling Control Act, including the legal requirement that the burden of proving his or her qualifications to receive any license is on the applicant.
- 4. The Commission, when evaluating the applicant's pending application for a regular Cardroom business license, will consider the conduct of the applicant and its employees, if applicable, during the term of the applicant's temporary license.
- 5. Notwithstanding any other limitations on this temporary license, it is also subject to the discipline and penalties provided in Article 10 and Article 11 of the Gambling Control Act. The issuance of this temporary license is without prejudice to the Bureau's prosecution of an accusation.
- 6. The granting of this temporary license in no way diminishes the responsibilities or powers of the Bureau in enforcing the Gambling Control Act and other applicable laws and regulations with respect to the temporary license.
- 7. This temporary license will only be valid as long as an application for a regular license is currently pending.
- 8. The holder of this temporary license shall pay all applicable fees associated with that license as if the temporary were a regular license.
- 9. If a regular license is not issued within the valid time period of the temporary license, the temporary licensee may submit a request for a new temporary license.
- 10. Upon issuance or denial of a regular license, this temporary license shall become invalid.
- 11. The holder of a temporary license shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Gambling Control Act and Commission and Bureau Regulations.
- 12. The Commission may impose additional conditions to this temporary license in its sole discretion at any noticed public meeting. The imposition of additional conditions does not entitle the temporary licensee to an evidentiary hearing under the Gambling Control Act or Commission regulations.
- 13. Any temporary license issued will be cancelled or conditioned as provided in Section 12128 of Title 4 of the California Code of Regulations.
