

**NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF
APPLICATION AFTER HEARING**

The Matter of the Application for a Finding of Suitability Tribal Key Employee Regarding MARK EDWARD KRUSPE came on for hearing before the California Gambling Control Commission on June 28, 2017. On September 19, 2017 the Commission issued a Decision and Order after hearing. A Request for Reconsideration was timely filed, staying the effective date of the Decision and Order, and on November 16, 2017 the Commission granted reconsideration.

On December 18, 2017, the California Gambling Control Commission, pursuant to Title 4, California Code of Regulations section 12017(c), deemed abandoned Respondent Mark Kruspe's Application for Tribal Key Employee Finding of Suitability, dated June 23, 2014.
