Title 4. Business Regulations.
Division 18. California Gambling Control Commission.

CHAPTER 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

ARTICLE 1. DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL PROCEDURES.

§ 12008. Request for Regulations.

(a) A person may submit a petition, resubmit an incomplete petition, or request reconsideration of a previously submitted petition to the Commission on form Petition for Adoption, Amendment, or Repeal of Regulation, CGCC-CH1-05 (New 04/22).

(b) In order to be complete, the petition must clearly and concisely state:

(1) The substance or nature of the regulation being requested to be adopted, amended, or repealed;

(2) The reason for the request; and,

(3) All necessary references to the authority of the Commission to take the requested action.

(c) Within 10 business days of receipt of the petition, the Executive Director, pursuant to Section 12006, will send an acknowledgement of receipt of the petition to the petitioner.

(d) Within 30 calendar days of receipt of the petition, the Executive Director will review the petition, assign the petition a unique identifying number, provide the petitioner with the assigned unique identifying number and do one of the following:

(1) If the Executive Director determines the petition is incomplete the petition be returned to the petitioner with an explanation of how it is incomplete.

(2) If the Executive Director determines the petition is complete, the Executive Director will do one of the following:

(A) Notify the petitioner that the petition has been denied, and provide an explanation of the basis for the denial based upon the merits of the petition; or,

(B) Notify the petitioner that the petition has been approved, either in whole or in part, and if the Executive Director has determined that additional adoptions, amendments, or repeals will be necessary.

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1 (e) If the Executive Director has determined that the petition has been approved, either in whole or in
2 part, within 30 calendar days of submittal, the Executive Director will provide notice, pursuant to Section
3 12006, to the Commission’s rulemaking list, as provided in Business and Professions Code sections
4 11346.4, paragraph (a)(1), and on its website, of the Commission’s intent to issue a Notice of Proposed
5 Action, including a tentative public hearing date, as provided in Business and Professions Code sections
6 11346.4 and 11346.8.
