**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS READOPTION MEETING AND ANTICIPATED PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Commission Fees Modernization Project**

NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION TO APPROVE COMMENCEMENT OF THE FORMAL RULEMAKING PROCESS FOR THE READOPTION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS CONCERNING:  
COMMISSION FEES MODERNIZATION PROJECT (CGCC-GCA-2021-05-E)

This is to inform interested parties that the California Gambling Control Commission (Commission) has scheduled a regulations meeting for the consideration to commence the emergency rulemaking process for the second readoption of emergency regulations concerning the Commission Fees Modernization Project. The regulations meeting has been scheduled for **June 23, 2022 at 10 a.m.** Please refer to the attached Notice and Agenda for further details.

Prior to any action by the Commission to readopt the proposed emergency regulations, the public will be given an opportunity to comment on any aspect of the proposal. **You are advised, however, that comments made at this Commission meeting or submitted to the Commission in writing regarding this meeting will NOT be forwarded to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL); therefore, such comments directed to the Commission are NOT comments submitted to OAL in accordance with Government Code Section 11349.6.**

The proposed readoption will be submitted to the OAL following Commission approval of the proposed text. Government Code Section 11346.1(a)(2) and Title 1, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 48 requires that, at least five (5) working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to OAL, the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency regulation to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five (5) calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulation as set forth in Government Code Section 11349.6(b).

**NOTICE OF ANTICIPATED PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD CONCERNING:  
COMMISSION FEES MODERNIZATION PROJECT (CGCC-GCA-2021-05-E)**

If this emergency proposal is readopted by the Commission, the proposal will be submitted to OAL. Upon submission, OAL will have ten (10) calendar days within which to review and make a decision on the proposed emergency regulation readoption. If approved, OAL will file the emergency regulation with the Secretary of State, and the emergency regulation will become effective for 90 days. Within the effective period, the Commission will continue to proceed with a regular rulemaking action (certificate of compliance).

The Commission anticipates submitting the proposed readoption of the emergency regulations to the OAL following the Commission meeting scheduled for June 23, 2022. After submission, OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6.

Assuming the Commission's readoption as proposed, a copy of the regulations should be listed on OAL's website on **June 24, 2022**. Written comments must be received by **BOTH** the Commission and OAL no later than five calendar days after filing by **June 29, 2022**, to the following:
